The lode line of each location of this claim was run directly upon the ground and the several corners established by means of off-sets from the lode lines.

All tie lines were run directly upon the ground or figured thru the lines of this survey.

The west $\frac{1}{2}$ section corner, section 17, T. 25 S., R. 58 E., M.D.M., is marked by a gray limestone, 5x10 ins. showing 8 ins. above a mound of stone, chiseled, " $\frac{1}{2}$ ", on the west face.
