

INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with an Ainsworth Light Mountain Theodolite Transit. The courses were deflected from true meridian as determined from direct solar observations. The distances were measured with 100 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.

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REPORT.

The lode line of each location of this claim was run directly upon the ground and the several corners established by means of off-sets from the lode lines. All tie lines were run directly upon the ground or figured thru the lines of this survey.

The S.W.Cor. Sec. 35, T.21 S., R. 63 E., M.D.M., is marked by a porphyry stone with two notches cut on the east face and four notches cut on the west face.

Survey No.4455, Annex lode :-

All corners mentioned herein are pine posts, 4 ins. square, properly set and marked as approved.
