

FINAL OATHS FOR SURVEYS.

5.

Shaft, which bears from Cor. No. 4, S 88° 27' E., 647.5 ft., 5X7 ft., 10.0 ft. deep.

Shaft, which bears from Cor. No. 4, S 86° 23' E., 635.4 ft., 5X7 ft., 10.0 ft. deep.

Cut, northerly end of which bears from Cor. No. 5, S 33° 30' E., 212.0 ft., 5 ft. wide, 6 ft. face, running S 5° W 18.0 to southerly end. All of the above mentioned improvements was claimed by the West End Extension Mining Company.

Note:- The disagreements between these field notes and the location certificate of this claim are due to errors in the latter.

Instrument.

This survey was made with a Berger transit. Courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. Distances were measured with 100 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.

Report.

The 1/4 Sec. Cor. on the south boundary Sec. 34, T 3 N., R 42 E., M.D.B and M is a stone 6X18 ins., 5 ins. above ground, marked 1/4 on the north face.

All corners of Sur. No. 2484, are posts properly scribed with their respective corner and survey numbers.

All corners of Sur. No. 4450, are posts properly scribed with the initial of the claim, corner and survey number.
