Instrument.

This survey was made with a Berger transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined from direct solar observations. Distances were measured with 100 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.

Report.

The 1/4 Sec. Cor. on the south boundary Sec. 28, T 3 N., R 42 E., M.D.B and M, is a stone 6X8 ins., 8 Ins. above ground, marked 1/4 on the north face.

All corners of Sur. No. 2400, General Miles et al lodes and Sur. No. 2662, McGregor No. 1 et al lodes, are posts properly scribed with their respective corner and survey numbers:

All of the lodes embraced in Sur. No. 2662, McGregor No. 1 et al lodes, together with all of the lodes embraced in Sur. No. 4557, Old Hickory No. 1 et al lodes, belong to claimant herein.

Owing to the fact that mining operations have been temporarily discontinued the hoisting equipment which is utilized in connection with operations conducted through the main working shaft is not in use at the present time. Consequently I was unable to make an examination of this improvement underground. In support of my report on this improvement I am including in these field notes, affidavit of J. D.
