

This survey was made with a Berger transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined from direct solar observations. Distances were measured with 100 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.

Report.

The 1/4 Sec. Cor. on the east boundary Sec. 26, T 3 N., R 42 E., M.D.B and M, is a stone 8X8 ins. 10 ins. above ground, chiselled 1/4 on the north face.

Cor. No. 3, Sur. No. 3880, Merger No. 1 lode, Cor. No. 4, Sur. No. 4093, Homestake lode, Cor. No. 2, Sur. No. 4152, Iceberg No. 2 lode and Cor. No. 4, Sur. No. 4153, Sky No. 2 lode are posts properly scribed with the initial of the claim, corner and survey number.
