

REPORT.

The lode line of this location was run directly upon the ground and the several corners established by means of offsets from the lode line. The tie line was run directly upon the ground.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor.between Secs.33 and 34, T 8 N., R 35 E., M.D.M. is a limestone boulder 6 x 8 x 24 ins. set in a mound of stone, chiseled $\frac{1}{4}$ on west face.

Sur.No.40 Silver Guardian Lode:

All corners are pine posts, properly set and scribed with the number of the corner and survey. I find the courses of line 3-4 and 4-1 to be N 73°13'E and S 41°54'E respectively.

Sur.No.41 Tip Top No.2 lode.

All corners are pine posts, properly set and scribed with the number of the corner and survey. I find the course and distance of line 3-4 to be N 53°50'E 580 ft.

Sur.No.44 Turk Lode;

All corners are pine posts, properly set and scribed with the number of the corner and survey. I find the courses of line 2-3 and 1-2 to be N 75°47'W and S 13°58'E respectively.

NOTE. - The discrepancies between these notes and those in the amended location certificate are due to errors in the latter.
