A power house, the N. E. Cor. of which bears from Cor. No. 1 Rose Bush Lode S. $32^{\circ} 37' W.$ 152.4 ft. 35 x 67 ft. Course of long side S. $23^{\circ} 56' E.$

A refinery building, the N. W. Cor. of which bears from Cor. No. 1 Rose Bush Lode, S. $0^{\circ} 48' E.$ 418.1 ft. 20 x 24 ft. Course of long side N. $22^{\circ} W.$

An assay office building, the N. W. Cor. of which bears from Cor. No. 1 Rose Bush Lode S. $5^{\circ} 15' W.$ 509.8 ft., 16' x 25 ft. Course of long side East and West.

The concentration and cyanide mill building, the N. W. Cor. of which bears from Cor. No. 1 Rose Bush Lode, S. $5^{\circ} 02' W.$ 618.4 ft.; and irregular shaped building the long side of which runs S. $14^{\circ} W.$ 156. ft. thence easterly at right angles, 65 ft. thence northerly at right angles 66 ft. thence easterly at right angles 49 ft., thence northerly at right angles 62 ft. thence easterly at right angles 23 ft. thence northerly at right angles 28 ft. thence westerly at right angles 137 ft. to the N. W. Cor.

INSTRUMENT

This survey was made with a Buff & Buff Mining Transit with 4-1/2 inch plates and full vertical circle, the graduations on each reading to single minutes. Courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. Distances were measured with 100-ft. and 500-ft steel tapes.

REPORT.

The boundaries of the various claims of this survey were run directly on the ground and all lines were either run directly or calculated from traverses so run.

The 1/4 Sec. Cor. on the north line of Sec. 8, T. 26 N. R. 48 E. M.D. B. & M. is a black rock 4 x 6 x 11 ins. set in small mound of stones marked, "1/4", and with a larger mound of rock 2 ft. westerly therefrom.

The N. W. Cor. Sec. 8 T. 26 N. R. 48 E. M.D. B. & M. is a 3/4 in. iron pipe set in a small pile of rock.

All corners of Sur. No. 4506 Cortez Millsite are wood posts set in mounds of rock and earth.

Cor. No. 3 of Sur. No. 38, Arctic Lode is a 3 x 4 in. partly burned
