INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a A. Lietz and Co. 6 inch plate, transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with 100 and 300 ft. steel tapes.

REPORT.

The lode line of each location of this claim was run directly upon the ground, and the several corners established by means of offsets from the lode lines.

The S.W.Cor. Sec. 27, T 3 N., R 42 E., M.D.B and M. is a stone, 6x6 ins. showing 10 ins. above ground. chiseled with one notch on the south and three notches on the east side. This is the nearest existing section corner to be found.

Sur. No. 4306 Kotte Lode.

None of the posts of this lode were found on the ground. The courses and distances used to figure the conflict were taken from the official plat of the approved field notes.

Sur. No. 2400 Merry X., Doctor, Tommy. White Swan, Clara A, T.R.B. Imperial, Isabella, Julia B and North Star lodes. None of the posts of any of said lodes
