Report.

The lode line of the location of this claim was run directly upon the ground and the several corners established by means of offsets from the lode line. All tie lines were run directly upon the ground.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. between secs. 19 and 20, T 19N, R 44E, (M. D. B. and M.), is a granite stone, properly set and marked, and of the size as described in the field notes of the public land survey thereof.

All corners of this survey are missing. The survey was located in the same relative position to Surv. No. 47, Southern Light lode as shown in the approved field notes thereof. The courses and distances of all lines were taken as given
