All corners of this survey are missing. The survey was located in the same manner and the same position as previously located by me in Surv. No. 3719, Vulcan et al lods. The courses and distances of all lines were taken as given in the approved field notes thereof.

Surv. No. 119 Sampson lode.

All corners of this survey, except Cor. No. 4, are missing. The survey was located in the same position as previously located by me in Surv. No. 3719, Vulcan et al lods. The course and distance of line 2-3, being N. 43° 30' W, 1483.1 ft, and of line 3-4, S. 46° 30' W, 590.9 ft.

Surv. No. 134 Brannan lode.

The survey was located in the same position as previously located by me in Surv. No. 3719, Vulcan et al lods. It being identical with Surv. No. 3715 Brannan lode.

Surv. No. 3313, Moss Fraction lode.

Cors. Nos. 1 and 4 are gone, the survey was located in the same position as previously located by me in Surv. No.
