## Report.

The lode line of the location of this claim, was run directly upon the ground and the several corners established by means of offsets from the lode line. All tie lines were run directly upon the ground.

The corner of Secs. 25 and 36, T19N, R43E, M. D. B. and M. is a granite stone, 6x10 ins. by 10 ins. above ground, with a mound of earth west of corner. Chiseled with 1 notch on S. and 5 notches on N. edge. This is the nearest corner of the public survey.

## Surv. No. 3700 Mizpoh lode.

All corners were rotted and broken off, but their positions were determined, from the stumps remaining in the ground, and from their position with regard to Cor. No. 1, Surv. No. 3700, Edwards lode, and Cors. Nos. 1 and 4, Surv. No. 3700 Golden Eagle lode. I find all courses and distances to be correct as approved.

## Surv. No. 3700, Golden Eagle lode.

Cors. Nos. 1 and 4, are pine posts, properly set and scribed with the number of the corner and survey. Cors. Nos. 2 and 3, are identical with Cors. Nos. 1 and 4, Surv. No. 3700 Mizpoh lode, and their positions were determined in the same manner as these corners. I find all courses and distances to be correct as approved.
