the center of which is on the lode line, S 43° 24' W, 775 ft. from the center of line 4-1, 3 ft. wide, 30 feet long, 35 ft. deep. The long way is along the lode line. This working is on the vein, and was excavated in the process of taking out ore, and now shows ore in the ends and bottom.

Instrument

This survey was made with a C.L. Bergen and Sons transit No. 3369. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with 5 ft. and 300 ft. steel tapes.

Report.

The lode line of the location of this claim was run directly upon the ground and the several corners established by means of offsets from the lode line. All tie lines were run directly upon the ground.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. secs. 11 and 14 T 25 N, R 22 E, Mt. Diablo B. and M. is an iron post, properly set, of the size, and marked as described in the field notes of the land survey thereof.
