

King, and Janey C. W. lodes, and two-eighths of the value has been applied as patent expenditure on Gold King Fraction and Janey C. W. Fraction lodes.

An undivided one-eighth interest in the value of the last 1000 feet of tunnel and of the drifts is hereby credited and applied as patent expenditure to each of the Journal, Dolerite and Granulite lodes.

INSTRUMENT

This survey was made with a Leitz transit.

The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations.

The distances were measured with 100 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.

REPORT

All lines and ties of this survey were run direct or by traverse upon the ground, submitted in separate report herewith.

The N. W. Cor. of Sec. 19, T. 19 N. R. 44 E. M. D. B. & M. is a stone 7 X 10 ins. showing 8 ins. above ground, chiseled 111 on north side and 111 on south side.

Sur. No. 3713, Ballard lode.

Cor. No. 1 is not in place as it falls in a road.

Cor. Nos. 4 - 1 Ballard and Gold King lodes is a granite stone 6 X 12 ins. showing 18 ins. above ground, chiseled 1 - 4 - 3 7 1 3 and 3 - D - 4 6 8 3.

From Cor. No. 1, the N. W. Cor. Sec. 19, T. 19 N. R. 44 E. M. D. B. & M. bears S. 64°23' W. 2699.60 ft.
