No. 12 A shaft, the center of which bears from Cor. No. 3, Victory No. 2 lode, N. 12° 30' W., 285 ft. Shaft 4 x 6 ft., 40 ft. deep, claimants unknown.

A shaft, the center of which bears from Cor. No. 3, Victory No. 2 lode, N. 39° 30' W., 425 ft. Shaft 4 x 6 ft., 12 ft. deep, claimants unknown.

INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a C. L. Berger and Sons mining transit, the courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations, the distances were measured with a 600 ft. steel tape.

REPORT.

The lines of this survey were run upon the ground. The NW. Cor. of Section 19, T. 6 N., R. 50 E., Mt. Diablo B. and M. is a basalt stone 6 ins. x 8 ins., 1 ft. above the ground with cross chiseled on top, with a mound of stone alongside. This is the only corner of the public land survey that could be found in the vicinity of this claim.

Lot No. 38, Heidelberg lode, corners No. 2 and 3 are cedar posts, 4 ins. in diameter, 2 ft. above ground in a mound of earth and stone, blazed and scribed 2-38H and 3-38H respectively. I find line 2-3 to be correct as approved. The course of line 3-4 was taken as approved.
