Demijohn lode, identical with Cor. No. 4 Chester No. 4 lode, is a hewed cedar post firmly set and properly marked; Cor. No. 3 Chester No. 1 lode, identical with Cor. No. 2 Chester No. 2 lode, is a hewed cedar post firmly set and properly marked.

Sur. No. 4008 Jumbo lode: Cor. No. 1 Jumbo lode, identical with Cor. No. 2 Pioche Central lode, is a 4 in. x 4 in. post firmly set and properly marked; Cors. Nos. 2 and 3 Pioche Central lode are 4 in. x 4 in. posts firmly set and properly marked. Found line 1-2 Pioche Central lode to be N. $46^{\circ} 18' W.$, 986.42 ft., instead of N. $46^{\circ} 09' W.$, 986.42 ft., as approved. Found line 1-2 Jumbo lode to be N. $46^{\circ} 18' W.$, 1537.98 ft., instead of N. $46^{\circ} 09' W.$, 1500.0 ft. as approved.

Sur. No. 4132 Saranac lode: Cor. No. 2 Saranac lode, identical with Cor. No. 2 Tip Top lode, is a 4 in. x 4 in. post firmly set and properly marked; Cor. No. 3 Saranac lode is a 4 in. x 4 in. post firmly set and properly marked; Cor. No. 4 Saranac lode, identical with Cor. No. 1 Rustic lode, is a 4 in. x 4 in. post firmly set and properly marked; Cor. No. 2 Rustic lode fell in road, therefore not established. W.C. for Cor. No. 2 Rustic lode firmly set and properly marked. Cor. No. 1 Rustic No. 1 lode is a 4 in. x 4 in. post firmly set and properly marked.

The cor. for secs. 17, 18, 19, 20 was not found after a diligent search. The 1/4 cors. between secs. 17 and 18, between secs. 18 and 19, between 19 and 20 were not found after a diligent search. The sec. cor. for secs. 13, 24, 18, 19, T. 1 N., R. 66 E., and T. 1 N., R. 67 E., M.D.M. is a limestone 10 ins. x 5 ins. x 8 ins. above ground with a mound of stone 3 1/2 ft. west; a B.T., an 8 in. pine, S. $5^{\circ} W.$, 92 ft. dist. Cor. has 3 notches on north and 3 notches on south edges.
