

Survey No. 4818

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The survey of Gabbs Exploration Mill Sites No's 1 & 2 is identical with the locations as staked on the ground.

EXPENDITURES.

The improvements and the value of the labor and improvements made upon these mill sites, by the claimant are as follows:--

A tungsten concentrating mill, steel frame, covered with corrugated iron, fully equipped with plant and machinery, in full operation at the time of survey, size 54 ft. long by 42 ft. wide, course of side, north, with extension covering crushing plant 68 ft long by 30 ft. wide. The NW. Cor. of main building bears S.62°49'W. 208 ft. dist. from Cor. No. 4, Gabbs Exploration Mill Site No. 2
Value about \$35,000.

A steel fabricated warehouse and office, size 20 ft. wide by 30 ft. long, course of side north, the SW. Cor. of which bears N.45°11'E. 397 ft. from Cor. No. 2, Gabbs Exploration Mill Site No. 2
Value \$2,500.

A frame house, 24 ft. long by 16 ft. wide, course of side, north, the SW. Cor. of which bears N.63°39'E. 383 ft. from Cor. No. 2, Gabbs Exploration Mill Site No. 2
Value \$1,000.

A tailings pond about 450 ft. square, spreads over part of both mill sites, as shown on map. Eventually covering both areas as these tailings are being impounded for future treatment.

OTHER CORNER DESCRIPTIONS & SUPPLEMENTAL DATA.

The corner of Sections 27, 28, 33 and 34, T. 12 N. R. 36 E. M.D.M. is a limestone boulder 5 x 10 ins., showing 10 ins. above ground marked with 1 notch on south side and 3 notches on east side, with mound of stone alongside.

The corners of Sur. No. 4769B, are all 4 ins. square posts, 3 ft. above ground firmly set in mounds of earth and stone and well scribed and marked with corner, claim and survey designations.
