No. 3 of the MARBLEHEAD MILLSITE NO. 12 millsite, running N. 51°10' E., 1,000 ft. to the end. This pipeline when completed will deliver water from the well for mining and milling purposes.</p>

	<p>The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 15 and 16, T. 34 N., R. 68 E., was found monumented with a limestone rock, 18 ins. x 9 ins. x 6 ins., mkd. 1/4 and bearing trees.</p>
