## LOCATION

The survey of the Pilot Claim placers is located in the NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. 14, SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. 14, NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. 15 and NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. 15, T. 34 N., R. 68 E., Mt. Diablo Meridian, unsurveyed.

The survey of the Pilot Claim placers are identical with the respective locations or amended locations as marked on the ground.

## EXPENDITURES

The improvements and the value of the labor and improvements made upon or for the benefit of each of the placer locations embraced in said mining claims by the claimant or its grantors are stated in the notes of Mineral Survey No. 4962.

The purpose of these improvements are for the development of the sixteen placers of this survey (the forty placers of MS 4962, the twenty-six placers of MS 4964 and Pilot Claim #8 placer and Pilot Claims 8-A to 8-G placer, inclusive, described by aliquot parts in Section 10, T. 34 N., R. 68 E., M.D.M., Nevada) all of which are contiguous placer claims owned in common and within the range of the benefit of said improvements.

These improvements afford the most practical and economical means of developing each of the placers.

Five hundred dollars or over has been expended in these improvements in such a manner as tends to the development of each placer of this survey, subsequent to its location and to the time since which common ownership and contiguity have prevailed; therefore, an undivided one-ninetieth interest in their value is hereby credited to each of the placers.

No portion of or interest in these improvements has been credited heretofore as patent expenditure to any placer claims, except as listed heretofore.

OTHER CORNER DESCRIPTIONS  
AND SUPPLEMENTAL DATA

The cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16, T. 34 N., R. 68 E., was re-established in the survey of MS 4962 with an iron post, 1/2 ins. diam., surrounded by a rock collar, 18 ins. x 10 ins. x 6 ins.

The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 15 and 16, T. 34 N., R. 68 E., was found monumented with a limestone rock, 18 ins. x 9 ins. x 6 ins., mkd. 1/4 and bearing trees.
