Trench No. 5, the N end of which bears N. 1°45' E., 571 ft. from Cor. No. 1 of the MRDC-1 lode; 12 ft. wide, 2½ ft. deep, running S. 72° W., 150 ft. 166 cubic yards of material removed.

Trench No. 9, the W end of which bears S. 53°25' W., 47 ft. from Cor. No. 3 of the MRDC-1 lode; 18 ft. wide, 4 ft. deep, running N. 88° E., 100 ft. and S. 70° E., 180 ft. 746 cubic yards of material removed.

OTHER CORNER DESCRIPTIONS AND SUPPLEMENTAL DATA

The ¼ cor. of secs. 4 and 9, T. 27 N., R. 40 E., Mt. Diablo Mer. was found to be monumented with a 1 in. diam. iron post and brass cap, 19 ins. out of the ground, instead of 9 ins. as described in the official record.

The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9, and 10, T. 27 N., R. 40 E., Mt. Diablo Mer., is an iron post, 2 ins. diam. and brass cap firmly set and properly mkd. as approved.

The line from the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10 to the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 9 was found to be S. 89°59'20" W., 2,640.21 ft. as determined in M.S. No. 4951 instead of West, 2,641.32 ft. as approved.

The line from the ¼ cor. of secs. 4 and 9 to the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9 was found to be N. 89°56'58" W., 2,640.71 ft. as determined in M.S. No. 4951 instead of West, 2,641.32 ft. as approved.
