<p>Northeast corner Section 27, T. 25 S., R. 59 E., MDM: Found a pile of stones, but no individual stone as described in the Official 1883 Record. In November 1954, a Record of Survey (Book 3, Page 67) was filed on said Section 27. The status of this corner as reported at that time was "Corner not found - not set."</p>	
<p>Southeast corner Section 27, T. 25 S., R. 59 E., MDM: Found a pile of stone and a 2 in. x 2 in. stake with nail, but no individual Stone as described in the Official 1883 Record. Corner area falls in a definite active floodplain. In November 1954, a Record of Survey (Book 3, Page 67) was filed on said Section 27. The status of this corner as reported at that time was "Found marked stone in mound of earth and rock."</p>	
MEMORANDUM	
<p>U.S. Highway No. 91 was built in the mid-thirties by the State of Nevada and received a 400 ft. wide easement of Federal land for its right-of-way. In 1967 when Interstate No. 15 became operational, the State of Nevada relinquished all of its interest in this Right-of-Way to the county of Clark, and it was designated as Las Vegas Boulevard South.</p>	
<p>Documentation for this action (Resolution Relinquishing Portion of Highway Right-of-Way) was recorded in Book 344, Instrument 303841 on July 10, 1973 at the Clark County Recorder's office.</p>	
<p>The claimant, herein, successfully petitioned Clark County for reduction of the Right-of-Way width to 100 feet.</p>
