OTHER CORNER DESCRIPTIONS AND SUPPLEMENTAL DATA

M.S. No. 5041, M.S. No. 5042 and M.S. No. 5043 were surveyed concurrently.

The cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23, and 24, T. 22 N., R. 50 E., Mt. Diablo Meridian, was found monumented with a limestone, 17x15x8 ins., mkd. with 3 notches on the south edge and 1 notch on the east edge. This corner will now become the cor. of secs. 23 and 24 only as shown on Nevada Protraction Diagram No. 158. Perpetuated the original position of the marked stone with an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., set 25 ins. in the ground, with a 3½ ins. diam. aluminum cap mkd. secs-23-24-T22N-R50E-1989, buried the original marked stone on the East side of the aluminum post.
