At Cor. No. 1 of the POST No. 1 lode, identical with Cor. No. 1 of the POST No. 2 lode, Cor. No. 1 of the POST No. 5 lode, and Cor. No. 1 of the POST No. 6 lode, all of this survey.

The cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, Tps. 36 N., Rs. 49 and 50 E., Mt. Diablo Meridian, bears N.  $9^{\circ}04'51''$  W., 3780.69 ft. dist. monumented with an iron post,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., firmly set showing 10 ins. above ground, with a properly marked brass cap.

No local bearing objects or bearing trees available.

183.68 Intersect the E-W center line of the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of sec. 19, T. 36 N., R. 50 E., Mt. Diablo Meridian, at a point from which

The S  $\frac{1}{16}$  sec. cor. of secs. 19 and 24, Tps. 36 N., Rs. 49 and 50 E., bears S.  $89^{\circ}04'58''$  W., 600.07 ft. dist., hereinafter described.

The SW  $\frac{1}{16}$  sec. cor. of sec. 19, T. 36 N., R. 50 E., not monumented, bears N.  $89^{\circ}04'58''$  E., 728.38 ft. dist.

721.80 Cor. No. 2, identical with Cor. No. 2 of the POST No. 2 lode of this survey.
