OTHER CORNER DESCRIPTIONS AND SUPPLEMENTAL DATA

The cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, Tps. 36 N., Rs. 49 and 50 E., Mt. Diablo Meridian, was found monumented with a properly marked 2½ ins. diam. brass cap showing 10 ins. above ground.

The cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, Tps. 36 N., Rs. 49 and 50 E., Mt. Diablo Meridian, has been destroyed by mining activity. The position was calculated base upon the information recorded on Record of Survey File No. 10190 of the official Records of Eureka County, Nevada, and was not remonumented at the time of this survey due to current mining activity.

The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 24 and 25, T. 36 N., R. 49 E., Mt. Diablo Meridian, is lost. The point was
