

TRUCKEE PLACER

Beginning at Cor.No. 1 of the Truckee placer, identical with Cor. No. 1 of the Weber placer of this survey, and Cor. No. 4, M.S. No. 4761 Canyon No. 6 placer.

An existing weathered 4 ins. x 4 ins. redwood post, scribed C6-4-4761. Replaced the redwood post with an iron post, 24 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 23 ins. in the ground, with a $3\frac{1}{4}$ ins. diam. aluminum cap mkd. Truckee-1-Weber-1-5030-C6-4-4761; from which

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of Secs. 13 and 18, T. 20 S., Rs. 63 and 64 E., M.D.M., bears N. $44^{\circ}58'35''$ E., 1867.29 ft. dist., hereinbefore described.

The cor. of Secs. 13, 18, 19, and 24, T. 20 S., Rs. 63 and 64 E., M.D.M., bears S. $45^{\circ}01'07''$ E., 1868.64 ft. dist., monumented with an iron post, firmly set, extending 9 ins. above the ground, with a properly marked brass cap.

An existing weathered 4 ins. x 4 ins. redwood post, scribed C6-3-4761 with R.L.S. Tag No. 3393. Replaced redwood post with an iron post, 24 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with $3\frac{1}{4}$ ins. diam. aluminum cap mkd. Truckee-2-5030-C6-3-4761.
