Total value of expenditures this survey: \$312,264.00. Number of mining claims included in this survey: 18. Allocation of proportionate share of expenditures to this survey: $\$312,264.00 \div 18 = \$17,348.00$.

The improvements are in progress for the development of the eighteen lodes of this survey, which are all the contiguous lode claims owned in common within the range of benefit of said improvements.

These improvements afford the most practical and economical means of developing each of the lodes.

Five hundred dollars or over has been expended in these improvements in such a manner as tends to the development of each lode of this survey, subsequent to its location and to the time since which common ownership and contiguity have prevailed; therefore, an undivided one-eighteenth interest in their value is hereby credited to each of the lodes.

No portion of or interest in these improvements has been credited theretofore as patent expenditures to any lode claims.

OTHER CORNER DESCRIPTIONS AND
SUPPLEMENTAL DATA

The cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31, and 32, T. 33 N., R. 43 E., MDM, was found monumented with a $\frac{3}{4}$ ins. diam. rebar with a $3\frac{1}{4}$ ins. diam. aluminum cap flush with the ground, surrounded by a mound of stone, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. diam., 15 ins. high, cap mkd. 29-30-31-32-T33N-R43E-1892-1990-RLS 5517. Original $26 \times 18 \times 5$ ins. stone mkd. with 1 notch and 5 notches was found in base of rock mound.

The cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32, and 33, T. 33 N., R. 43 E., MDM, was found monumented with a set rock, $24 \times 12 \times 6$ ins. above the ground, mkd. with 4 notches on the east and 1 notch on the south.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 32 and 33, T. 33 N., R. 43 E., MDM, was found monumented with a set rock, $19 \times 5 \times 19$ ins. above the ground, mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on the west face.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 28 and 29, T. 33 N., R. 43 E., MDM, was found monumented with a set rock, $7 \times 14 \times 13$ ins. above the ground, mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on the west face. Mound of rock, 3.5 ft. diam., 1 ft. high, 4 ft. west of marked stone.

The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32, and 33, T. 33 N., R. 43 E., MDM, was found monumented with a set stone, $14 \times 20 \times 12$ ins. above the ground, mkd. with 4 notches on east edge and 2 notches on west edges. Mound of rock, 4 ft. diam., $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, 2 ft. north of marked rock.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 28 and 33, T. 33 N., R. 43 E., MDM, was found monumented with a set rock, $10 \times 5 \times 20$ ins. above the ground, mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on the north face, scattered mound of rock NW of mkd. rock.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of secs. 29 and 32, T. 33 N., R. 43 E., MDM, was diligently searched for, but not found.

The line from the cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31, and 32 to the cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32, and 33, T. 33 N., R. 43 E., MDM, was found to be N. $89^{\circ}48'53''$ E., 5332.92 ft. dist., instead of N. $89^{\circ}55'$ E., 5260.20 ft. dist., as approved.
