The cor. of Tps. 30 and 31 S., R. 64 E. (surveyed townships) and Tps. 30 and 31 S., R. 65 E. (unsurveyed townships), Mount Diablo Meridian, bears S. 63°03'57" W., 11,174.20 ft. dist.; monumented with a quartz stone 6 x 10 x 14 ins., 10 ins. above ground, in a mound of stone 3 ft. diam., properly marked, and with a nail and brass tag mkd. Avery Corp. RE 2002, set at center of stone.

The cor. of secs. 25 and 36, T. 30 S., R. 64 E., on the west line of unsurveyed T. 30 S., R. 65 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, bears N. 88°38'44" W., 9,929.70 ft. dist.; monumented with a basalt stone 10 x 12 x 18 ins., 10 ins. above ground, in a mound of stone 3 ft. diam., properly marked, and with a steel fence post set on the west side of the stone.

The cor. of secs. 13 and 24, T. 30 S., R. 64 E., on the west line of unsurveyed T. 30 S., R. 65 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, bears N. 42°34'42" W., 14,702.20 ft. dist.; monumented with an aluminum post, 2¼ ins. diam., projecting 8 ins. above ground, firmly set, surrounded by a mound of stone 3 ft. diam. to top of post, with a 3¼ ins. diam. aluminum cap mkd.
