on South side 1872 L: 120°.

Made Stone mound 6 feet diam: 3 feet high  
with pits as per instructions

From which Drummond Peak bears S. 28° W.

Mount Sargent bears S. 22° 45' W.

No other bearings convenient.

Land rocky Tables: rolling and broken,  
Sage brush and scrub Junipers.

### South on 22<sup>nd</sup> mile.

Var 18° 45' East.

64.55 To steep Bluff, bears E. and W. and ascend.

80.00 Set Post 6" x 6" square and 6 feet long  
Deposited charred Block marked C.N.  
Marked Post on North side @ 22 miles:  
on West side C.A.L.; on East side N.E.N. and  
on South side 1873 L: 120°.

Made mound of earth and Stone 7 feet diam:  
4 feet high, with pits as per instructions.

From which a Juniper tree 18" diam:  
bears N. 63° 15' W. distant 30 links marked  
Tree B.T. C.

A Juniper 12 inch diam: bears S. 43° 10' W.  
distant 98 links, marked tree B.T. C.

Another Juniper 15 inch diam: bears S. 25° E.  
distant 30 links, marked Tree B.T. N.

Another Juniper tree 10 inch diam: bears N.  
44° 15' E. distant 19 links: marked tree B.T. N.

Land broken tables, with scattering Juniper  
trees and bushes, sage brush and rock.

Useless in all respects: the rock sharp  
and cutting.

### South on 23<sup>rd</sup> mile.

Var: 18° 45' East.
