Cliff of mesa, bears  $S. 22^{\circ} 45' E.$   
 First 55 chains barren flat covered with  
 little Hillocks: The last 25 chains in dry  
 Bed of Lake, utterly worthless throughout,  
 A more miserable Country I never saw,  
 it could not be worse than it is.

South on 39<sup>th</sup> mile.

Var:  $18^{\circ} 30' East.$

On Old Bed of Alkali Lake.

80.00 Set Post 6" x 6" square and 7 feet long  
 Deposited charred Block marked C. N.  
 Marked Post on north side @ 39 miles, on  
 West side @ A L; on East side N E V; and  
 on South side 1872 L.  $120^{\circ}$ .  
 Made mound of earth 7 feet diam: 3 feet  
 high, with pits as per instructions.  
 From which Drummond Peak bears  $S. 72^{\circ} 00' W.$   
 Mount Sargent bears  $S. 58^{\circ} 00' W.$   
 Coles Peak bears  $S. 32^{\circ} 45' W.$   
 Nat Mountain bears  $S. 12^{\circ} 00' W.$   
 Land level as a floor, dry bed of alkali  
 Lake, without growth of any kind.

South on 40<sup>th</sup> mile.

Var:  $18^{\circ} 05' East.$

40.00 Enter Hillocks.

80.00 Set Post 6" x 6" square 7 feet long, and  
 deposited charred Block, marked C. N.  
 Marked post on north side @ 40 miles: on  
 West side @ A L; on East side N E V; and on  
 South side 1872. Lon:  $120^{\circ}$ .  
 Made mound of earth 6 feet diam: 3 feet  
 high, with pits as per instructions.  
 From which Drummond Peak bears  $S. 71^{\circ} 50' W.$   
 Coles Peak bears  $S. 34^{\circ} 15' W.$
