

Chs lks

South on 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ th mile.

Var: 16° 15' East.

- Ascend steep mountain from Post.
- 2.84 To large Pine tree 40 inch diam 5 lks N. of line. Blazed and marked tree C.L.S.
- 2.95 Pass large Pine 32ⁱⁿ diam: 3 lks East of line. Blazed and marked tree N.E.
- 12.00 Cross Ravine, Course N.E.
- 20.97 Line tree 40ⁱⁿ diam: Blazed tree & marked same West side C.A.S. East side N.E.
- 35.00 Top of ridge bears N.E. & ascend Easterly slope of steep hill.
- 42.00 Cross deep gorge bears off east very steep falling off into the Truckee River.
- 67.00 South side of ridge bears off E. & th. steep descent.
- From which High Peak east of Truckee River, bears S. 40° 50' E.
- Set flag for triangulation.
- 80.00 Marked a Pine tree 10ⁱⁿ diam: on the North side 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ miles: West side C.A.S. East side N.E. and South side 1072 L. 120°, near edge of deep ravine.
- Land rough and broken, with fine Pine timber.

South on 1 $\frac{1}{5}$ th mile.

Var: 16° 15' East.

- 3.00 To deep Ravine.
- 10.00 Across same, Course East, very rough and ascend
- 14.00 Top of ascent and descend steep gorge.
- 15.00 Foot of gorge and ascend.
- 22.47 Across deep gorge, Course East.
- 23.00 Descend steep rocky Bluff on East slope which falls into the Truckee River very abruptly.
- 44.05 Set a cast iron monument of the following dimensions viz: 8 ft long 12 inches square at the
