77.00 Set Pine Witness Post 7" x 7" square 7 ft long.

Marked Post on N.W. side @ 26.7 miles 77 chains. N.E. side N.E.; S.W. side S.W. and S.E. side 1873.

Made mound of stone 8 ft dia 14 ft high.

Deposited chanced Block marked CN.

No pits. too rocky.

78.00 Cross old bed of East Walker River 300 ft wide. Course N.E.

80.00 On gravel bar and in willows. Witness post set three chains back from this point.

Altitude by aneroid 6600 feet above the level of the sea.
