

Thence over small ridge and descend stony side to end of 80 chains. Made excavation and planted aspen post 7 feet long by 8 inches square at top: deeply marked on the north face "I" on the South "N" on the East 44 M on the West 42 T. Built mound of earth of prescribed size, dug trench and pits. Land stony. Soil 3<sup>d</sup> rate.

Bearings: to top bluff S 46° 30' W distance 1 1/4 miles, to top bluff N 79° 48' W distance 1 mile, to mountain covered with loose rock N 19° 49' E distance 3 miles.

Thence descend 22.50 chains to ravine and ascend 35 chains to bluff ridge and crossing ridge then descend cross small water drain and slight ascent to mound of earth and stone. Made excavation and planted seasoned mountain mahogany post 7 feet long by 7 inches square at top: deeply marked on the north face "I" on the
