 Bearings: to ripple of mountain top
 S 54° 32' E distance 15 miles, to Hat butte
 S 37° 10' W distance 8 miles, to mountain
 butte N 17° 03' distance 30 miles. Along
 bar 18° 10' E. Line is traversing the flats
 of elevated mountains. Considerable rocks.
 Soil 2nd rate.

Thence west descend 6 chains enter North
 end of swamp. 26.50 chains to rocky flat
 top mountain and descend 54 chains to
 bluff. Thence to end of mile in low place
 top mountain. Thence ascend low ridge
 and descend over top of mountain to
 20 chains. Quilt mound of earths of
 prescribed size, dug trenches and pits.

 end of mile on top ridge very rocky.
