

Ascend 22. 50 chains summit, 45 chains to Summit. Thence to end of 80 chains over rolling sage brush hills. Built sodded mound of earth of prescribed size, dug trench and pits. Planted Stone 24 x 15 x 4 inches, on top: deeply marked on the North face "I" on the South "N" on the East

Bearings: to distant mountain peak S 85° 32' E, distance 34 1/2 miles, to Hat Butte S 44° 50' E, distance 8 1/2 miles, a long range between line and "Hat" butte, to high mountain peak S 68° 24' W distance 30 miles.

Land (mountain table land). Soil 2nd rate.

Thence over level ground 20 chains cross bluff descend 54 chains to dry water course North ascend steep 74 chains to bluff.

Thence to end of 80 chains on tongue between bluffs. Built mound of earth of prescribed size, dug trench and pits. Placed Stone, 24 x 10 x 5 inches, on top: deeply marked on the North face "I" on the South "N" on

Bearings: to mountain peak S 34° 14' E, distance 30 miles, to rocky end bluff N 65° 51' E, distance 3/4 mile, to distant mountain peak S 67° 17' W distance 29 miles.
