

Ascend foot hills of high mountain ridge 26 chains cross creek flowing to East by North, 38.50 chains ascend to bluff 41.50 chains cross dry Creek from North ascend to end of mile. Made excavation and planted Alder post 7 feet long by 8 inches square at top, deeply marked on the north face "O" on the South "N" on the East 213 M on the West 42 Ft. Built mound of stones and earth of prescribed size, on slope mountain side down to South and ravine and Creek, dug trench and pits.

Bearings: to mountain peak N 40° 10' E distance 16 miles, to high mountain peak S 54° 10' E distance 33 miles, to ledge rocks top ridge S 49° 55' W distance 2 1/2 miles.

Land (mountainous). Soil rocky 3^d rate.

Ascend very rough mountain side 38 chains to bluff ascend 70 chains to bluff. Mile ends on edge rocky bluff and high summit (foresight for 25 miles) (marked 2 ledges of rock distant 10 feet, through which the line runs, respectively on the north face "O" 42 Ft. on the South "N" 214 M 2 dps.)
