

East. White Ends on slope down to East-South-East. Made excavation and planted juniper post 7 feet long by 10 inches square at top: deeply marked on the north face "O" on the South "N" on the East

289 M on the West 4 1/2 T. Built mound of stone of prescribed size, dug trench and pits.

Bearings: to small rock mound S 63° 05' E. distance 1 mile, to distant mountain S 75° 48' E. distance 3/8 miles, to rocky East end small ridge S 30° 45' W distance 1 mile.

Ascend 29 chains to Knob, ascend 60 chains to bluff thence ascend to rocky top hill and end of mile. Marked lone juniper tree, 1 1/2 inches square, on the North face "O" on the East

290 M on the West 4 1/2 T. North of line 70 links marked juniper tree, 17 inches diameter, south line 1 chain "N".

Land juniper ridges. Soil rocky.

Thence ascend 47 chains to bluff edge high ridge, thence over mountain top descend 56 chains to dry Creek course down to South east ascend to end of mile on slope to East.

Built large mound of stone, dug trench and pits.

Bearings: to lone juniper 15 inches diameter N 79° 10' E. distance 3 chains, to blazed juniper 2 feet diameter, marked "O" 4 1/2 T. N 75° 25' W distance 3 chains, to blazed juniper 2 feet
