

to head of Spring Branch. Mile ends on north side steep hill large Cliffs above it descending slope to valley. Made excavation and planted juniper post 7 1/2 feet long by 7 inches square at top: deeply marked on the north face "O" on the South "N" on the East 299 M on the West 42 L. Built mound of earth and stone of prescribed size, dug trench and pits.

Bearings: to bluff south edge ridge N 85° 54' W distance 15 miles, to high peak S 75° 52' W distance 15 miles, to top bluff mountain S 36° E distance 6 chains. Land mountainous. Soil rocky. Some scattered juniper.

Then descend the Creek bed being north 15 chains spring flows west, then cross wagon road to old Fort Warner. Thence to end of Mile on level rocky table. Made excavation and planted juniper post 7 feet long by 8 inches square at top: deeply marked on the north face "O" on the South "N" on the East 300 M on the West 42 L.

Built mound of stone of prescribed size, dug trench and pits, cone juniper from which post was cut South by West 3 chains.

Bearings: to high mountain peak S 74° 22' W distance 12 miles, to mountain peak
