	From the corner of secs. 25, 30, 31, and 36, on E. boundary of township, heretofore described, I run	
	West, on true line, between secs. 25 and 36.	
	Over gently rolling bench land.	
37.50	Small dry wash, drains NE.	
40.00	Set blue limestone, 30x11x8 ins., 23 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, raise mound of stone, 2 feet base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet high, N. of corner. Pits impracticable.	
41.00	Small dry wash, drains NE.	
44.66	Intersect boundary line between Utah and Nevada, 11.72 chains N. of 141st mile post on said boundary, which is a fir post 4x4x24 ins., above ground, marked and witnessed as described by Surveyor General, where I set a sandstone, 20x10x4 ins., 15 ins. in ground, for closing cor. to secs. 25 and 36, marked C C with 1 groove on E, and 1 groove on S. faces; dig pits, 24x18x12 ins., crosswise on each line N. and S. 3 feet, and E. 7 feet distant, raise a mound of earth, 4 feet base, 2 feet high, E. of corner.

24.00	Wash, 3 feet deep, 15 links wide, drains NE.	
28.50	Wash, 8 feet deep, 1.00 ch. wide, drains NE.	
40.00	Set a quartzite stone, 16x8x6 ins., 11 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face; dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., E. and W. of stone, 3 feet distant; raise a mound of earth, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet high, N. of corner.	
40.25	Wash, 2 feet deep, 15 links wide, drains NE.	
44.49	Intersect boundary line between Utah and Nevada, 11.90 chains N. of 140th mile post, on said boundary, which is a fir post, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General, where I set a flint stone, 14x10x6 ins., 9 ins. in the ground, for closing corner to secs. 24 and 25, marked C C with 1 groove on E, and 2 grooves on S. faces; dig pits, 24x18x12 ins., crosswise on each line N. and S. 3 feet, and E 7 feet distant, raise a mound of earth, 4 feet base, 2 feet high, E. of corner.	
	From corner of secs. 13, 18, 19, and 24, on E. boundary of Tp., heretofore described.	
	West, on true line, between secs. 13 and 24.	
	Over gently rolling bench.
