

## SOUTH BOUNDARY OF T. 19 S., R. 20 W.

	<p>From the Tp. corner, heretofore described, I run W. on true resurvey line, bet. secs. 1 and 36, and at 40.00 chains intersect <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> sec. corner, which is a mound with deposit, but no stake can be found. I obliterate all traces of old corner, and establish corner in same place, as follows:</p> <p>Set a blue limestone, 14x8x6 ins., 9 ins. in the ground, for <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> sec. corner, marked <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> on N face; dig pits, 18x18x12 ins. E. and W. of stone, 3 feet distant; raise a mound of earth, <math>3\frac{1}{2}</math> feet base, <math>1\frac{1}{2}</math> feet high, N. of corner. And at 46,38 chains intersect Utah and Nevada boundary at closing corner, instead of 45.60 chains as given by the Surveyor General, which is a charred post, 4 ins. square, 2 feet above ground, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General, which is 1.32 chains S. of 154 mile post, which is a cedar post, 4 ins. square, 2 feet above ground, marked Utah on east; 154 on S; Nevada on W; and L 37 W on N. faces. Instead of 4.00 chains S. of the 152 mile post as given in the original field notes of the survey of this line.</p>
