8.06	Fence, bears N. and S. The 100 mile cor. established by the Indian Service Survey, which is an iron post, 3 ins. diam., marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general, bears N. 27 lks. dist.
45.00	Low spur, slopes SE. Descend SE. slope, 420 ft. to
84.75	The witness cor. to the 99th mile cor. which is a stone 24x18x15 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general.
