 5 ins. 12 ins. in the ground, marked N on S., I on N.,
 M 87 on E and L 42 on W face.

 West on a random line, from M P 87.
 80.65 Fall 92 lks. N. of M.P. 88, which is a lava stone,
 21x14x4 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, marked N M 88
 on S. and I L 42 on N face.

 West on a random line, from M.P. 88.
 109.28 Fall 63 lks. N. of M.89, which is a lava stone,
