 Land rolling. Thence to end of 80 chains and 152nd mi. Built mound of stone of prescribed size, dug trench. Placed stone on top size 22x14x10 ins: deeply marked on the north face "I" on the south "N" on the east 152 M on the west 42 L.
- 152 M Land worthless.
 Could get no bearings.
- 152M 72c At 152 M 72 chs. struck boundary line bet. Idaho and Oregon and 4 chs.

 IDAHO & south of corner monument as established by myself in 1868. Monument in excellent condition. Apportioned off at rate of 25 lks. per mi. this difference bet. the two determinations. Thence to end of 80 chs., did not erect mound for 153 mi. Compared ch. with std. and found it correct.
- Ran over rising sagebrush hills to end of 80 chs. and 154th mi. in low flat bet. hills. Built mound of earth and stone of prescribed size, dug trench. Marked two stones, same size, 16x11x3 ins.: on the north face "O" on the south "N" on the east. 154 M on the west 42 L.
- Iand moderately rolling, Could get no bearings because of low situation. Thence over like country to end of 80 chs. and 155th mi. Built mound of stone and earth of prescribed size, dug trench. Placed two stones on top marked one, 14x6x5 ins., on the south face "N" on the east 155 M, another, 16x12x4 ins., on the north face "O" on the west 42 L.
- Iand and soil same as last mi.

 Bearings: to sharp peak Queen river mountains S51°43'W dist. 17 mi., to distant peak Goose Cr. mountains S43"04'E, distance 45 mi. Only objects. Thence gradual ascent over miserable sagebrush country to end of 80 chs. Built mound of stone of prescribed size, dug trench. Placed stone on top, 26x22x6 ins.: deeply marked on the north face "0" on the south "N" on the east 156 M on the west 42 L.
- Bearings: to sharp peak Queen river mountains S48"23'W dist. 17 mi., to sharp peak Bruneau range S71°04'E dist. 54 mi. Only bearings could be had. Mag. var. 18"30'E.

 Thence ascend over rolling sagebrush hill to end of 80 chs. Built mound of earth of prescribed size, dug trench. Planted stone on top, 22x13x6 ins.: deeply marked on the north face "O" on the south "N" on the east 157 M on the west 42 L.
