	From the 151st mile cor. I run East, retracing the 151st mile.
81.16	Fall 61 lks. S. of the 150th mile. The course of this line is N.89°34' E.
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	East, retracing the 150th mile.
103.78	Fall 92 lks. N. of mile post, 148 + 59.00 chs. The course of this line is S.89°30' E.
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	East retracing the 149th mile.
55.36	Fall 66 lks. S. of the 148th mile cor. The course of this line is N.89°19' E.
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	East, retracing the Idaho-Nevada State Boundary.
80.00	Find no trace of the 147th mile cor.
160.00	Find no trace of the 146th mile cor.
242.85	Fall 57 lks. N. of the 145th Mile cor. The bearing of this line is therefore S.89°52' E.
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	East, retracing the 145th mile.
80.53	Fall 39 lks. N. of the 144th mile cor. The course of this line is S.89°43' E.
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	TRUE LINE
	Aug. 26, 1915: At 9h 0m a.m., appt.t., I set off 42°0' N. on the lat. arc; 10°39½' N. on the decl. arc; and determine a meridian with the solar at the 151st mile cor. on the Idaho-Nevada State Boundary, which is a granite stone, 16 X 12 X 10 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general.
	Thence I run N.89°34' E. on the Idaho-Nevada State Boundary. Over rolling land, through scattering undergrowth.
