True Line

Mile cor. 127, is a basalt stone, 12x6x10 ins. above ground, firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described by the surveyor general.

Thence

N. 89° 36' W., on 128th mile.

Over level land, through dense undergrowth.

19.39 Mid-point for 1/4 sec. cor. as hereinafter determined.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 cor. of sec. 25, with brass cap mkd.

19.76 Rim rock, 10 ft. high, bears NW. and SE., faces SW. Descend 310 ft. over SW. slope.

53.46 Dry wash, 10 lks. wide, course N. Ascend 50 ft. over NE. slope.

56.00 Spur, slopes N.; descend 40 ft. over NW. slope.

59.29 Point for closing cor. of secs. 25 and 26, as hereinafter determined.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 25 and 26, with brass cap mkd.
