80.67	The 121 mile cor., which is a lava stone, 24 X 12 X 8 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general. Land, rolling. Soil, volcanic ash; 3rd rate. Undergrowth, sage. July 10, 1915.
	Thence N.89°2' W., Over rolling land, through scattering undergrowth.
80.50	The 122nd mile cor., which is a lava stone, 18 X 14 X 8 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general. Land, rolling. Soil, clay; 2nd rate. Undergrowth, sage.
	Thence S.89°35' W. Over rolling land, through scattering undergrowth.
81.21	The 123 mile cor., which is a lava stone, 24 X 12 X 8 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general.
