From the witness cor. to the 100 mile cor., which is a stone, 24 X 24 X 24 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general, S.89°5' E., on Idaho-Nevada State Boundary
Over rolling land, through scattering undergrowth.

8.06 Fence, bears N. and S.

The 100 mile cor. established by the Indian Service Survey, which is an iron post, 3 ins. diam., marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general, bears N. 27 lks. dist.

45.00 Low spur, slopes SE.

Descend SE. slope, 420 ft. to

84.75 The witness cor. to the 99th mile cor. which is a stone 24 X 18 X 15 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general.

Land, rolling.

Soil, rocky loam; 2nd and 4th rate.

No timber.

Undergrowth, sage, aspen, and laurel.

N.89°2' E., on the 99th Mile.

Over rolling land, through scattering undergrowth.

7.25 Road, bears N. and S.

73.15 Will Ratliff's house, bears North 13.00 chs. dist.

78.15 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N.

85.05 The 98th Mile cor., which is a cottonwood post, in mound of stone, no visible markings

Alongside of which is a lava stone, 30 X 20 X 10 ins. marked N 98 on S and I 42 on N face.

Land, rolling.

Soil, rocky loam; 2nd and 4th rate.

No timber.

Undergrowth, sage, laurel, and aspen.
