	Thence, S.1°57'W., on true line bet. secs. 31 and 36.(N $\frac{1}{2}$) Over rolling land; thru scattering undergrowth.
1.00	Center of wash, 1 ch. wide, course NW.
21.00	Enter hills, bears NE. and SW.; ascend 30 ft.
28.00	Spur, slopes NW.; descend 60 ft.
29.50	Wash, 40 lks. wide, course NW.; ascend 155 ft.
31.50	Wash, 1 ch. wide, course NW.; continue on NE. slope.
39.88	The orig. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., which is a granite stone, 10x10x8 ins. above ground, set in a mound of stone 2 ft. base and 1 ft. high and marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. side.
(W $\frac{1}{2}$)	At point for cor. Set an iron post 3 ft. long 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with the original stone set alongside, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
	S 36 S 31 1932 and rebuild the mound of stone 3 ft. base and 2 ft. high, W. of cor.
	Thence, S.0°32'W., on true line bet. secs. 31 and 36.(S $\frac{1}{2}$) Ascend 40 ft. over NE. slope.
4.00	Long spur, slopes NW.; descend 40 ft. on SW. slope.
8.00	Ravine, course NW.; ascend 240 ft. on N. slope.
17.20	Ridge, bears N.60°E. and S.45°W.; slopes sharply SW.; a spur slopes W. from the ridge, at this point; descend 255 ft. over SE. slope.
29.00	A wash, 1 ch. wide, course SW.; ascend 35 ft.
32.75	A spur, slopes SW.; descend 40 ft.
35.52	Intersect the California-Nevada State Boundary. Set an iron post 3 ft. long 2 ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone to top, for closing cor. of T.28 S., R.60 and 61 E., with brass cap marked.
