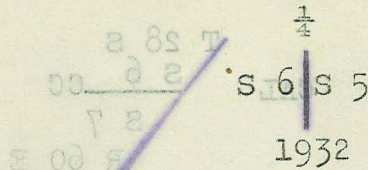


Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisions
of
T. 28 S., R. 60 E.

chains

- 4.75 Change to broken NE. slope; descend 550 ft.
40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long 1 in. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone to top, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked



Descend 20 ft.

- 40.45 Foot of mountains, bears NW. and SE.; continue over rolling desert land, general NW. slope.
41.00 A wash, 1 ch. wide, course NW.
68.25 A wash, 1 ch. wide, course W.
74.25 A road, bears NE. to Lucy Grey mine and SW. to Desert.
80.25 The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on N. bdy. of Tp., hereinbefore described.
Land, rough mountainous and rolling desert.
Soil, rocky, 4th rate; and gravelly, 3d rate.
Undergrowth, creosote brush, cacti and sage.

Retracement of a Portion of the Von Schmidt
California-Nevada Boundary.

The 560 mile cor. on the Von Schmidt California-Nevada State Boundary is the remains of a mesquite stake in a mound of stone and earth, 6 ft. base and 3 ft. high. As the Von Schmidt state line is now displaced by the line as determined by the Coast and Geodetic Survey, I obliterate evidence of this corner.

Thence, from point for cor.

S.45°35' E., on random 561st mile.

- 80.28 A point 4 lks. SW. of the 561 mile cor.; a mesquite stake 2 ins. sq., 3 ft. long, lying on a mound of earth, 6 ft. base and 1 ft. high; scribe marks on stake are visible but not legible. I obliterate evidence of this cor.

Thence, from point for cor.

S.45°36' E., on random line on 562d mile.

- 58.60 A point 114 lks. SW. of point for an unofficial clos. cor. S. secs. 7 and 18, T. 28 S., R. 60 E., hereinbefore described, and destroyed.

- 80.22 A point 31 lks. NE. of the 562 mile cor.; a mesquite stake 2 ins. sq., 40 ins. long, lying on a mound of earth and stone 6 ft. base and 3 ft. high and marked C 562 on NW., CAL on SW., NEV. on NE. sides. I obliterate all evidence of this corner.

Thence, from point for cor.

S.45°30' E., on random line on 563d mile.

- 80.21 A point 57 lks. SW. of the 563 mile cor.; a mesquite
