

Resurvey of a Portion of the West Boundary

chains

Land, mountainous and rolling desert.
Soil, gravelly, 3d rate and rocky, 4th rate.
Undergrowth, creosote brush and cacti.

Thence, south on a random line bet. secs. 1 and 6.

39.49 A point 295 lks. west of the orig. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.; a lime-
stone, 15x12x5 ins., set in a mound of stone 3 ft. base
and 1 ft. high and marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. side.

I obliterate all evidence of this corner.

Thence, from point for cor.

South on a random line bet. secs. 1 and 6.

22.46 Record dist.; find no trace of closing cor. of secs. 1
and 6.

40.45 Intersect an unofficial cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12; a
limestone, 16x12x8 ins., set in a mound of stone 2 ft.
base and 1 ft. high and marked with 5 notches on S. and
1 notch on N. sides.

From this cor.

An unofficial closing cor. of secs. 7 and 12 bears
S.0°10'E., 17.39 chs. dist.; a mound of stone 3 ft. base
and 2 ft. high.

An unofficial closing cor. of secs. 1 and 12, T.27 S.,
R.58 E., bears S.75°05'W., 14.61 chs. dist.; a mesquite
stake, 2 ins. sq., 2 ft. above a mound of stone 3 ft.
base and 1 ft. high and marked: TXXVIIS RLVIIIIE SI on
NE., SXII on SE., and CC on SW. sides.

I obliterate all evidence of these three corners.

Return to the cor. of Ts.26 and 27 S., Rs.58 and 59 E.

Thence, south on true line bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over a rolling and rocky SW. slope, thru scattering
undergrowth.

Descend 75 ft.

9.00 A ravine, course SW.; ascend 40 ft.

17.20 A spur, slopes SW.; descend 160 ft.

32.20 A wash, 30 lks. wide, course SE.; continue over rolling
land.

41.06 A point which is 40.00 chs. in latitude from the SE. cor.
of sec. 6, hereinafter described.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the
ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

1932 and raise a

44.46 Intersect the California-Nevada State Boundary.
