Descend 70 ft. over a general west slope.

53.04 Southern Sierras 2 wire line, bears N.46°05'E. and S.46°05'W.

81.66 The orig. cor. of secs. 8,9,16 and 17; a limestone, 12x6 x6 ins., set in a mound of stone 2 ft. base and 1 ft. high, and marked with 4 notches on S. and E. sides and a cross (+) on top.

At point for cor.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with the original stone corner set alongside, for cor. of secs. 8,9,16 and 17, with brass cap marked



1932 and rebuild the

mound of stone 3 ft. base and 2 ft. high west of cor.

From this point the L.A. & S.L. airplane beacon in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 sec. 8 bears N.30°46'W.

Land, nearly level desert.
 Soil, sandy, 2d rate; and gravelly, 3d rate.
 Undergrowth, creosote brush, sage and cacti.

South, on a random line bet. secs. 16 and 17.

40.00 Find no trace of orig. 1/4 sec. cor.

61.50 Record dist.; find no trace of clos. cor. secs. 16 & 17.

Return to the cor. of secs. 8,9,16 and 17.
 frac.


Thence, south on true line bet./secs. 16 and 17.

Over level desert land, thru scattering undergrowth.

25.65 Southern Sierras 2-wire line, bears S.46°05'W., and N.46°05'E.

36.69 Intersect the California-Nevada State Boundary.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of frac. secs. 16 and 17, with brass cap marked

mound of stone 2 ft. base and 1 1/2 ft. high north of cor.

From this point the 1 mile cor. bet. monuments 125 and 126 on the state boundary bears N.45°57'W., 2.63 chs. dist.; described in the field notes of the Portion of the California-Nevada State Boundary resurveyed under this group.

Land, level desert.
 Soil, sandy, 2d rate; and gravelly, 3d rate.
 Undergrowth, creosote brush, sage and cacti.
