34 and 35, T.26 S., R.58 E.; which township is unsurveyed, according to the official records; but I found other clos. cors. along the retraced Von Schmidt line which undoubtedly referred to T.26 S., R.58 E.)

79.98 A point 3 lks. SW. of the 549 mile cor.; a mesquite stake 2 ins. diam., 3 ft. above a mound of stone 5 ft. base and 1 1/2 ft. high, firmly set and marked as described in the official record.

I obliterate all evidence of this corner.

Thence, from point for cor.

N.45°28'W., on a random line on 549th mile.

5.60 A point 13 lks. SW. of an unofficial clos. cor. of secs. 27 and 34, T.26 S., R.58 E.; a mesquite stake, 2 ins. sq., 2 ft. above a mound of stone 2 ft. base and 1 ft. high; and marked TXXVIS RLVIIIIE SXXVII on NE., SXXXIV on SE.; and CC on W. sides.

I obliterate all evidence of this corner.

80.43 A point 9 lks. SW. of the 548 mile cor.; a mound of stone 5 ft. base and 3 ft. high, with remains of a rotted stake in center of mound.

I obliterate all evidence of this original cor.; and set a temp. cor. at the point.

The retracement of the Portion of the Von Schmidt State Boundary, NW. of the 548 mile cor., will be found in the field notes of the portion of T.25 S., R.57 E., Resurveyed under this group.

There is no final test of the solar attachment to be recorded.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The S. bdy. of frac. sec. 36, of this township, is on a broken and hilly SW. slope; and very rocky. The W. bdy. of frac. sec. 6 is on a gentle west slope of desert washland. Most of the interior of the township is part of a high and rocky mountain range, extending about N.20°W., and S.20°E.

80.12 A point 14 lks. SW. of the 550 mile cor.; a mesquite stake, 2 ins. sq., 3 ft. above a mound of stone and earth, 5 ft. base and 2 ft. high; marked as described in the official record.

I obliterate all evidence of this corner.

Thence, from point for cor.

N.45°28'W., on a random line on 550th mile.

80.59 A point 4 1/2 lks. SW. of an unmarked limestone, 20x20x10 ins., set in a mound of stone 3 ft. base and 2 ft. high.

I obliterate all evidence of this corner.
